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New & Used Unpainted Wood

\$9.00/Ton

This category is for loads that are 100% wood, including: Pallets, Wire Cable Spools, Plywood, Oriented Strand Board (OSB), Medium Density Fiberboard (MDF), Particleboard, Parallam™ OSL and similar products. This wood may include embedded metal such as nails or screws.

This category does not include wood that has been painted, stained or treated.

Co-Mingled Construction Debris and Shipping Crates

\$56.00/Ton

This category is for Shipping Crates and Co-Mingled loads from NEW construction job-sites. Typical construction waste such as: wood, steel, wire, aluminum, concrete, cardboard and plastic may be included in the load. This category also includes Timbers, Non-Treated Poles, Hardiplank, Weatherboard and other cement-fiberboard products, L.P. Siding, and Cedar Shakes. Please segregate gypsum from the rest of the debris and leave the gypsum in large pieces.

Gypsum Debris

\$56.00/Ton

This category is for NEW gypsum scrap from new project and gypsum debris from remodels and demolition.

A.H.E.R.A. documentation is required for all gypsum that has been installed and taped, painted or textured.

Wall sections must be delivered in large pieces.

DO NOT CRUSH THE GYPSUM

Demolition / Renovation Debris

\$50.00/Ton

This category is for Co-Mingled loads of wood debris from building demolition / renovation projects.

Documentation proving that an A.H.E.R.A. inspection was completed must be provided before loads will be accepted for processing. If asbestos containing materials were discovered during the A.H.E.R.A. inspection, you must provide documentation proving the asbestos containing materials were removed.

All mercury containing building materials must be removed such as but not limited to, thermostats, silent switches, float switches and fluorescent light tubes. Loads including mercury containing materials or evidence of mercury containing materials (broken lights) will be rejected.

Lead-Based Paint must be removed. We use XRF technology to detect lead in paint. Painted surfaces with more than 0.5 mg/cm² lead in the paint will not be accepted for recycle.

Land-Clearing Debris

\$4.00/yd³ (or) \$20.00/Ton

This category consists of Stumps, Brush and Tree Limbs.

Chipped Stumps & Brush

\$10.00/Ton

This category is for chipped or shredded land-clearing debris.

Creosote Treated Railway Cross Ties

\$20.00/Ton

This category is for creosote treated railway ties only.

This category does not include piers or pilings.

The creosote treated wood must not have been exposed to salt or brackish water.
